NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

1.1 The Championship will be governed by the 2013-2016 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia, the Rules of the Australian Cavalier 28 Class (except as any of these are altered by the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions) and by the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 Each yacht may be required to install bow stickers, if supplied by the Organising Authority and in the position requested.

2.0 ADVERTISING

The Regatta is classified as a Category C Event.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The Regatta is open to boats of the Cavalier 28 Class that fulfill the following requirements:

3.1.1 All helmspersons must be financial members of the Cavalier 28 Association and must be a member of a Yacht or Sailing Club and a member of Yachting Australia.

3.1.2 No crew member shall be a "professional" namely a person whose primary source of income is derived from boat building or maintenance, rigging, sail making or coaching sailing.

3.1.3 The helmsperson nominated on the entry form shall be deemed to be in charge of the yacht and no change in helmsperson shall be made without written consent of the Cavalier 28 Association. Any change of helmsperson must conform to paragraph 3.1.1 and 3.1.2.

3.1.4 Skippers are reminded that their yacht should comply substantially with the Class Rules as set out on the website www.cavalier28.com

3.1.5 Each yacht shall hold and lodge with the Organising Authority evidence of personal risk cover of no less than \$10,000,000 by way of a Certificate of Currency or Policy Document copy.

3.1.6 Each yacht shall hold and lodge with the Organising Authority a current valid Special Regulations Compliance Certificate, minimum of Category 7.

3.1.7 Entry shall be made using the Entry Form below and shall be submitted with the Organising Authority prior to 1700 hours on Friday 11th October 2013. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Authority upon payment of a late fee of \$20.00.

4.0 ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is included in your current membership of the Cavalier 28 Owners Association.

5.0 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

5.1 Sunday 20th October 2013

- Racing First Warning Signal 11:00 hours Sydney Harbour
- Three (3) windward leeward races are scheduled
- Trophy Presentation & BBQ – SASC club house ASAP after racing

6.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available after 1800 hours on Wednesday, 16 October and will be emailed to all registered entrants

7.0 REGATTA SITE and OWNERS BRIEFING

The Regatta site will be at SASC Club House

8.0 RACING AREA

The Racing Area shall be on the waters of Sydney Harbour between Kirribilli and Sow & Pigs Reef.

9.0 COURSES

The courses shall be as detailed in the Sailing Instructions comprising Windward/Leeward short course races.

10.0 SCORING

The Low Point System Appendix A will apply. Three (3) races are scheduled of which two (2) completed races are required to constitute a series. Each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. The lowest series score wins.

11.0 ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES

The Two (2) Turn Penalty, Rule 44.2, shall apply for breach of a Rule of Part 2.

12.0 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

12.1 It is the intent of the organizing authority and race committee to use marine VHF radios to communicate with the fleet on Channel 73.

12.2 A boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats.

13.0 PRIZES

13.1 The Cavalier 28 Championship Trophy shall be awarded to the winner of the series on scratch.

13.2 The Cavalier 28 Championship Plate shall be awarded to the winner of the series on handicap.

13.3 Prizes will be awarded to yachts placed first to third overall on scratch and on handicap. The presentation will be held at SASC as soon as possible after racing on Sunday. No boat will earn two prizes.

13.4 The awarding of any prizes shall be subject to decisions of outstanding protests and appeals.

14.0 BOAT ACCOMMODATION

- 14.1 Boats may be accommodated at SASC on the Saturday night of the regatta subject to the availability of limited space.
