The Cavalier 28 Class Yacht, NSW Championships will be incorporated into the Sydney Harbour Regatta 2013.

The Notice of Race for the Sydney Harbour Regatta 2013 will be deemed the NOR of this Championship event except as modified by the following clauses:-

Eligibility

- 1.1 All helmspersons must be financial members of the Cavalier 28 Association and must be a member of a Yacht or Sailing Club and a member of the Yachting Association of NSW.
- 1.2 No crew member shall be a "*professional*" namely a person whose primary source of income is derived from boat building or maintenance, rigging, sail making or coaching sailing.
- 1.3 The helmsperson nominated on the entry form shall be deemed to be in charge of the yacht and no change in helmsperson shall be made without written consent of the Cavalier 28 Association. A change of helmsperson must conform to paragraph 2.1 and 2.2.
- 1.4 Skippers are reminded that their yacht should comply substantially with the Class Rules as set out on the website www.cavalier28.com .
- 1.5 Competing yachts must hold a valid Compliance Form for the size of the #1 Genoa and the largest spinnaker. The Compliance Form is available on the Cavalier website and must accompany the entry form. The Association will validate the Compliance Form.

2 Number of Races

- 2.1 Five Races are scheduled as per the Sydney Harbour Regatta 2013 NOR.
- 2.2 There shall be no discards and a boat's total score will be the sum of its scores in all races completed.
- 2.4 A minimum of two (2) races are necessary to constitute the series.

3. Trophies and Prizes

3.1 Trophies

- 3.1.1 The Cavalier 28 Championship Trophy shall be awarded to the series winner on Scratch.
- 3.1.2 The Cavalier 28 Championship Plate shall be awarded to winner of the series on Handicap.

4.2 Prizes

- 4.2.1 Prizes shall be awarded by the Association for first three places in the series on Scratch and Handicap. No boat will earn two prizes.
- 4.2.3 The awarding of any prizes shall be subject to decisions of outstanding protests and appeals.

5. Entries

- 5.1 Entries shall be made on the entry form attached to this Notice of Race and shall reach the Treasurer of the Cavalier28 Association by 2300 hrs on Saturday 22 nd February 2013.
- 5.2 Late entries will be accepted provided that the competitor has successfully entered the SHR and completed the Cavalier NSW Championship entry form.

6. Fees

- 6.1 Entry fee shall be \$ 100.00 should accompany the Entry Form. This fee will be waived for first time entrants in this event.
